

I thank my God every time I remember you. In all my prayers for ... you, I always pray c joy because of your partnership in the gospel...being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
(Philippians 1:3-6)

I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world....and I pray that now at last by God's will the way may be opened for me to come to you. (Romans 1:8-10)

For this reason, ever since I heard about your faith in the Lord Jesus, & your love for all the saints, I have not stopped giving thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers. (Eph. 1:15)

We have not stopped praying for you, asking God to fill you c the knowledge of His will through all spiritual wisdom & understanding...in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord. (Col. 1: 9-10)

We always thank God for all of you,...continually remembering before our God & Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Thes.1:2-3)

We ought always to thank God for you, brothers, &rightly so, bc your faith is growing more & more, & the love every one of you has for each other is increasing. Therefore, among God's churches we boast about your perseverance & faith in all the persecutions & trials you are enduring. . . . (2 Thes. 1:3)

I pray that the God who gives endurance &encouragement may give you a spirit of unity among yourselves as you follow Christ Jesus, so that c one heart & mouth you may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 15:5-6)

I pray that you may be active in sharing your faith, *so that* you will have a full understanding of every good thing we have in Christ. Your love has given me great joy & encouragement, bc you have refreshed the hearts of the saints. (Philemon 5-7)

I pray that the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (Phil. 4:6-7)

I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, give you the Spirit of wisdom & revelation, so that you may know him better. ... the eyes of your heart enlightened ... **that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and his incomparably great power for us who believe.** (Eph. 2:15ff)

I pray that out of His glorious riches he may strengthen you c power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith...that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, **to grasp how wide & long & high & deep is the love of Christ, & to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.** (Eph. 3:14-21)

[I pray that] the Lord would make your love increase & overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you. May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless & holy in the presence of our God and Father *when* our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones. (1 Thess. 3:13)

c this in mind, we constantly pray for you, that our God may count you worthy of his calling, and ... by his power ... fulfill every good purpose of yours and every act prompted by your faith. We pray this so **that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him,** according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Thess. 1:11-12)

May the God of hope fill you c all joy & peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow c hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. (Romans 15:13)

We have not stopped praying for you & asking God to fill you c the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom & understanding. And we pray this in order **that you may live a life worthy of the Lord & may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, being strengthened c all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, & joyfully giving thanks to the Father,** who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light. [Colossians 1:9-14]

May our Lord Jesus Christ himself & God our Father, who loved us & by his grace gave us eternal encouragement & good hope, encourage your hearts & strengthen you in every good deed & word. (2 Thes. 2:16-17)

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. And pray for us, too, **that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.** Pray that I may proclaim it clearly, as I should. (Col. 4:2-4)

I urge you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ & by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me. ...that my service in Jerusalem may be acceptable to the saints

there, so that by God's will I may come to you c joy & together with you be refreshed.^(Rom. 15:30-33)

Praise be to the God & Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.—to the praise of his glorious grace,^(Eph. 1:3)

But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ & through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him.^(2 Cor. 2:14-16)

I always thank God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus. For in him you have been enriched in every way...[confident] that He will keep you strong to the end, so that you will be blameless on the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.^(1 Cor. 1:4-9)

And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more & more in knowledge & depth of insight, so that you may be able to discern what is best & may be pure & blameless until the day of Christ, filled c the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God. Amen^(Phil. 1:9-11)
